Film analysis "Stand by me"

Stand By Me is about friendship, the friendship between a group of four young boys and in particular between two of them, Gordie and Chris. The four boys aim to find a missing boy and presumed dead in a small town named CastleRock in order to become famous.

The film is about the adventure of the journey and it also shows how young boys' difficulties in growing up in a small town with little hope for a successful future. We might say that there are two ends to the journey. The first is when the boys find the body while the second it is when we are told that the boys on starting at their new school they never talked to each other again.

Where is the film settled?

It is settled near CastleRock, Oregon in summertime.

Who are the main characters?

The main characters are four young guys. Their name is Chris, Gordie, Teddy and Vern. The four boys are a strange mixture of characters.

Gordie is the mature member of the group that likes to write and tell stories, but his father prefers his brother, who is dead. Vern is overweight and teased, especially by his brother and his friends. Chris comes from a family of alcoholics and criminals, but he is different from the rest of his family. Teddy is fearless and has emotional issues due to an abusive father.

One of the key conflicts in 'Stand By Me' is the one between the four boys and the older group with bullying aspects.

What are the relationships between the characters?

Stand By Me is about friendship. Although the four guys have a great relationship, they also display superficial and altruistic friendships. It is rather evident that Chris and Gordie have a much stronger relationship than the one with Teddy and Vern. They shared deep feelings, stories and support for each other. On the other hand, Teddy and Vern do not have the same support and courage as Chris and Gordie. This becomes clearer when the four boys are confronted with the older gang. As soon as Vern and Teddy understand they are in danger, they immediately run away and leave Chris and Gordie by themselves.

Throughout the adventure, all four boys have to learn how to survive with themselves, both from a mental a physical viewpoint. Despite Gordie has some relational problems with his parents, throughout the movie Chris is the most supportive friend which helps Gordie through the journey encourages him to continue writing stories despite his father's bad attitude towards him.

Where does the film develop?

The four boys start their journey following the train tracks and they come to a bridge. The rail bridge gets on for 40 miles to the south, southeast of Cottage Grove.

Then they continue into the forest and arrive to a swamp infested with leeches. When they come back to the tracks they discover the dead body. Finally, they return to town.
